Indicative Retail Prices Notice 8th March 2006

The following prices are the anticipated prices for Mogas, Diesel and Kerosene to apply at the pump (including GST) at the centres identified. These prices will take effect from 12.01am on Wednesday 8th March 2006, and reflect the Import Parity Prices (IPP) that will apply from that month until the next price change. The prices are for bulk fuel delivered to these centres and sold at retail service stations.
