PNG PORTS CORPORATION LIMITED - 2011 TARIFFS

The Independent Consumer & Competition Commission ('**Commission**') is responsible for regulating the tariffs and service standards of PNG Ports Corporation Limited ('**PNG Ports**') for the supply of Essential Port Services and Stevedoring Access at its declared ports throughout PNG through the PNG Ports Regulatory Contract ('**Contract**'). The regulated essential ports services are berthage, berthage reservation and wharfage services.

The Commission wishes to inform members of the general public as well as relevant industry stakeholders, pursuant to Clause 1.4 (a)(ii) of the Contract, that the following tariffs have been approved by the Commission for PNG Ports to apply on its regulated services for the 2011 regulatory year. These new rates will be effective as of **01st January 2011**.

5. TRANSHIPMENTS

The tariffs for transhipments (inward and outward charged separately) will be charged at, for overseas – 50%, and for coastal – 100%, of the respective approved wharfage tariffs in accordance with Schedule 1, Part A of the Contract, and payable at the port of transhipment.
